Hands Free in Boerne - DRIVE NOW, TALK OR TEXT LATER

Boerne approved an ordinance making driving and using a portable electronic device a citable offense. A person convicted of this offense **could receive a fine of \$200.**

Portable Electronic Device is defined as: a hand-held mobile telephone, personal digital assistant, MP3 or other hand-held music player, electronic reading device, laptop computer, pager, broadband personal communication device, global positioning or navigation system, electronic game device, or portable computing device.

The following activities while holding or touching a device **are prohibited:**

- ◆ dialing or deactivating a phone call;
- ◆ speaking in or listening to a conversation;
- ◆ viewing, taking, or transmitting electronic images;
- ◆ composing, sending, viewing, accessing, browsing, retrieving, or saving email messages, text messages, or other electronic data;
- ◆ entering or changing information in a global positioning or navigation system or any software or application designed for navigation;
- ◆ accessing or viewing an internet website or computer application; or
- ◆ playing a game.

A portable electronic device may be used if it is in a hands-free mode of operation; if used for obtaining emergency assistance to report a crime, traffic accident, medical emergency, or serious traffic hazard, or to prevent a crime about to be committed; or is due to the reasonable belief that a person's life or safety is in immediate danger.

Don't think it's okay to use a device while stopped at a traffic light, a vehicle must be at a complete stop to use your device.
