VAQUERO GARBAGE SERVICES:

NOTE: Do not dispose of batteries, used oil, antifreeze, paint, tires, or other hazardous materials in your garbage bins. Also, please do not dispose of dirt, rock sand or other heavy materials that may exceed the weight capacity of the cart. For the safety of their personnel, individual containers should not exceed 45 pounds, brush and limbs should be tied in bundles of less than 35 lbs. and two (2') feet in length

ACCEPTED RECYCLING ITEMS:

- Aluminum & Tin Cans
- Brown paper bags
- Cardboard or Paperboard
- Catalogs, magazines and phone books
- Chipboard (cereal boxes, shoe boxes, etc.)
- Colored paper
- Computer paper
- Envelopes
- Glass bottles and jars (all Colors)
- Newspapers and junk mail
- Plastic bottles and jugs No. 1-7
- Tin and steel cans
- Empty aerosol cans
- White ledger paper
- Treated wood

NO Styrofoam!

NO plastic wrap or bags!

VERY CLEVER CREDIT CARD SCAM WARNING: Be wary of accepting any gift or package delivered to your house, especially if it involves any kind of payment as a condition of receiving the gift or package. Also, never accept anything if you do not personally know or there is no proper identification of who the sender is. The only time you should give out any personal credit/debit card information is when you initiated the purchase or transaction!

There has been a scam involving a delivery with the carrier needing a delivery/verification charge requiring payment with a credit or debit card only. A mobile card machine having you enter a PIN/security number can be used to create a "dummy" card with all your card details including the PIN number. **BEWARE!!**
